A. To qualify for CSF membership this term, follow these guidelines:

- 1. You must earn a minimum of 10 points from last term's grades.
 - a. The first 4 points must be from LIST I (unless you are a senior applying for membership in June).
 - b. The first 7 points (including the four points described in "a" above) must be from LISTS I and II.
 - c. The remaining points may come from any list (I, II, III).
- 2. You must use no more than 5 courses from the 8 in a semester to qualify and you must have at least two courses in LIST I and at least three in LIST I and LIST II altogether. For example: 2 classes in LIST I and 1 in LIST II or 3 in LIST II.
- 3. No CSF points are given for physical education, courses taken in lieu of physical Education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerical and office/teaching assisting, and courses taken on a pass/fail basis.
- 4. CSF points are granted per term of work as follows:
 - a. a grade of A = 3 points.
 - b. a grade of B = 1 point
 - c. a grade of C = 0 points.
 - d. a grade of D or F in any course, even in one you cannot use to qualify, disqualifies you from membership at this time.
 - e. NOTE: You may add an extra point for A's and B's in all starred AP and Honors courses, however you may only do twice per term.
- B. Also remember:
 - 1. Term membership is based on the work in the previous term.
 - 2. You must reapply each term, August and January of each year.
 - 3. Courses you may use are listed on the reverse side. They are divided into LISTS I, II and III.
- C. List the 5 courses you are using to qualify in the proper location below. Consult the lists on the reverse side.
- D. In addition to this application form, you must submit a copy of your academic transcripts for the previous term and a **\$10.00** application fee. These are due by the close of the application period.
